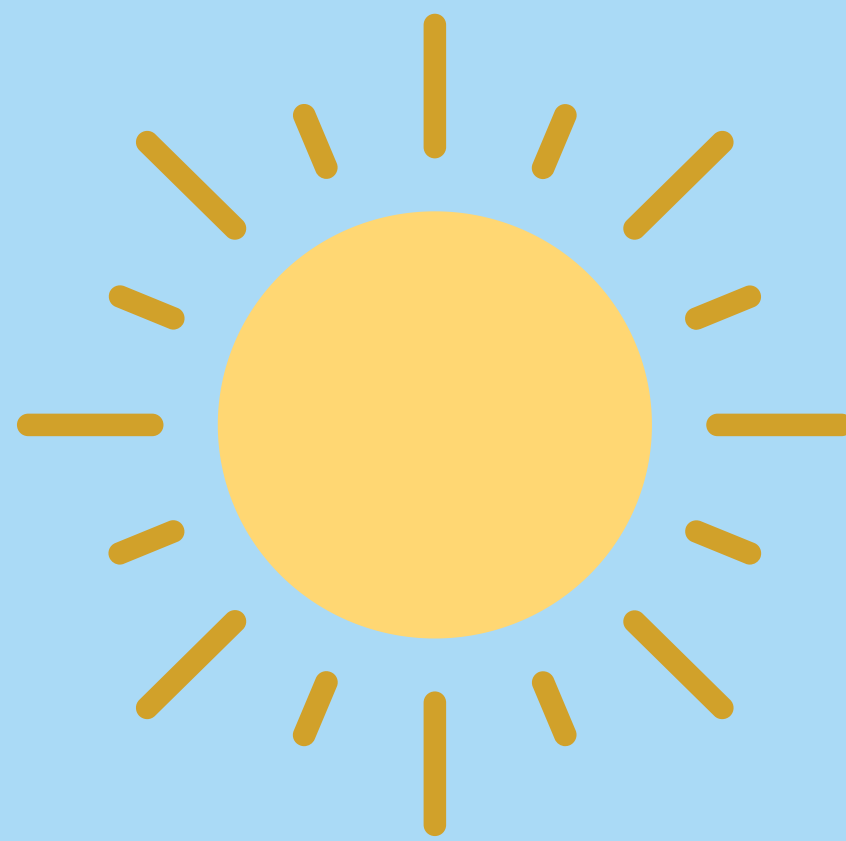


ARTISTS FOR GREEN TRANSPORT



Sustainability is becoming more important in our daily lives. In the past years, humans have impacted the environment in many ways. Some of Earth's resources cannot be replaced once these are used. Therefore, it is important that we care for our planet. One way of doing this is through small changes in our everyday life, for example our transport needs. Transport significantly impacts our air quality and there is a lot that each and every one of us can do to move around with less damage to the environment that we live in.

We, the Sustainable Mobility Team of Transport Malta, work to promote sustainable transport by encouraging people to use other modes besides the car and to switch to vehicles which do not depend on a combustion engine. Now we want to see transport from your eyes and are inviting you to send us your artistic creations such as drawings, photographs or a short video clip sharing with us your views and opinions on sustainable mobility.

This Competition is open to all primary school aged children attending State, Church and Independent schools. Submissions are split into two categories;
Category A is open for students in Year 1 – Year 3 (or equivalent) of primary school
Category B is open for students in Year 4 – Year 6 (or equivalent) of primary school



PRIZES AND PROMOTION

For EACH Category:

- A bicycle will be awarded to the student with the winning entry
- Your school will receive a bicycle rack to be installed for the use of students and staff
- 5 runners-up will receive a book related to the subject

Submissions will be received until 14th January 2022.

Entries will be judged on both originality and artistic merit and judges will be looking for an imaginative and inspiring response in relation to sustainable mobility/green transport. The winning submissions shall be announced and awarded by Transport Malta by the end of January 2022. A selected number of entries will be put on display on Transport Malta premises and on social media accounts of the Authority.

You are invited to express what sustainable mobility or green transport mean to you through your own drawing, photograph or short video clip.

Drawings: Should not exceed A3 size and are to be submitted unframed and unmounted.

Photographs: If printed should not exceed A3 size and are to be submitted unframed and unmounted

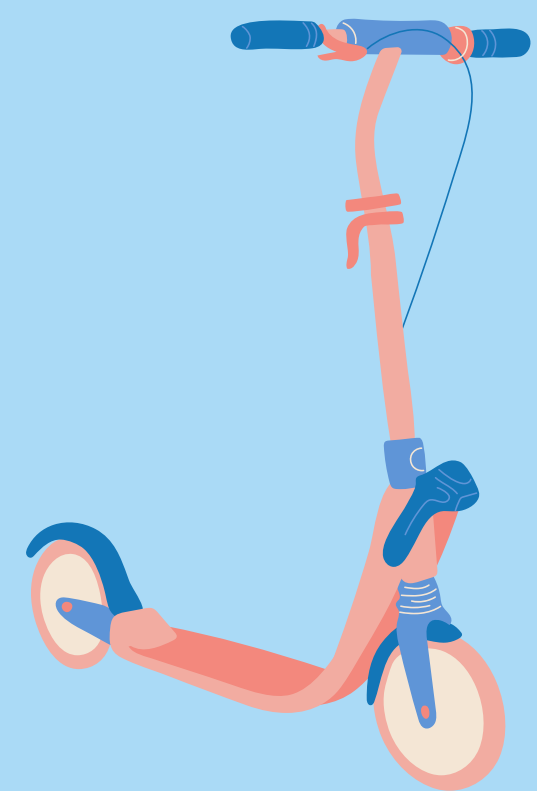
Video clips: Should not be longer than 60 seconds

Terms and Conditions

By entering the competition, schools and students confirm that they have read and understood, and agree to be bound by, the following competition rules:

- 1.The competition is open to all students in primary schooling in Malta and Gozo.
2. Entry into the competition is free, however, all materials for the creation and submission of the drawing, photograph or video clip must be provided by the school or the student.
3. All submissions must be the original idea of the student and not infringe on anyone else's copyright.
4. Submissions cannot be returned.
5. The winners of the competition shall be decided by a panel of judges who will be looking for creativity, originality and imagination in relation to the subject.
6. By entering the competition, students and parents/guardians give their consent to the Sustainable Mobility Unit within Transport Malta to use their work, free of charge, in any publicity and/or promotional activities. In particular, if an entrant is a winner of the competition, the entrant consents to having their name and their winning work exhibited/posted on the premises or on the website or social media of the Authority.
7. Winners must agree that they may be asked to be photographed and interviewed for publicity purposes.
8. No cash alternative to any prize is available and the prizes shall be non-transferable.
9. The Authority is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries.
10. The decision of the judging panel is final and binding on all submissions.
