For the second year, the Public Service is organising a competition with interesting prizes on the theme “X'tixtieq issir la tikber?”/ “What do you want to become when you grow up?”

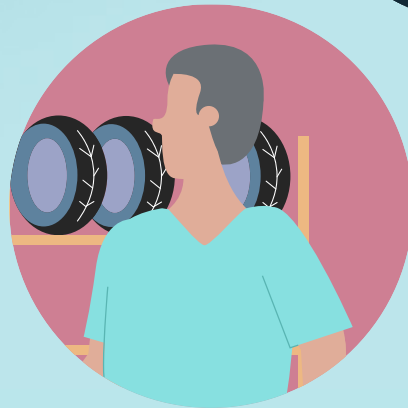
The competition is open to students from Year 4, 5 and 6 in all Primary Schools within the State, Church and Independent Sectors. The schools with the largest participation will also be rewarded.



1. THE THEME

“The Public Service - What do you want to become when you grow up?”

- Students are encouraged to create drawings, writings, photographs, and / or short videos related to the theme. They can do this by:
 01. imagining about what they want to become when they grow up or
 02. imagining a day in the life of a public officer of their choice.
- Careers chosen must be found within the Public Service.



2. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- a. Language used should be Maltese or English. Pictures are to be in .png or .jpg format and not more than 20mb. Written submissions are to be in .pdf format whilst videos in .mp4 format and not exceeding 100mb.
- b. Submissions are to be uploaded on the following link www.publicservice.gov.mt and if compliant with the theme, will be exhibited online following the prize giving ceremony.
- c. The deadline for the competition is 11th April 2022 at noon. Late applications or applications given by hand will not be accepted.



3. GUIDELINES ON HOW TO SUBMIT THE PROJECT

1. Access the website www.publicservice.gov.mt
2. Click on the related banner which takes you to the application section.



3. Fill in your details.
4. Upload the project.
5. You should receive a notification on the email you provided confirming that the submission was successful.
6. All submissions will be exhibited at the same time of the prize winning ceremony.

4. DATE OF ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

Winners will be informed by their respective school. The date of the prize giving ceremony and start of the online exhibition will be announced later on.

5. GENERAL TERMS

- a. Each individual participant is to send only one submission.
- b. Submissions related to the theme will be exhibited online and may be used by the Public Service, and exhibited, amongst others, on the Public Service Facebook page, along with the name and surname of the individual and the name of the school.
- c. Teachers are urged to encourage their students to participate in the competition and to support them in case they find difficulties when uploading.
- d. The judges' decision is final.
