School Council Elections 2023/2024
Nominations – Parents/Guardians

The time has come for the School Council Elections to be held.

The School Council is made up of:

- A President – who is nominated by the Minister for Education
- A Secretary/Treasurer – who is the Head of School
- Three representatives elected from among the Educators based at the school
- Three representatives elected from among the Parents/Guardians whose children attend this School.

Elections will be held between December 2022 and January 2023.

The excellent work and dedication of members who served on previous Councils left positive results in our school. Parents/guardians are therefore encouraged to participate in these elections by either volunteering as Council Members or by nominating other parents/guardians of children in our school.

Participation in these elections is of utmost importance and your cooperation is greatly appreciated in the best interests of the school and the students.


Nominations – Parents/Guardians

1. Nominations for parents/guardians for these Councils open on the 12th December 2022.
2. Nomination forms can be accessed and then submitted online at schoolcouncilelections.edu.mt
3. Parents/guardians of students attending this school can contest the election and vote for the School Council.
4. **Only one parent/guardian** from each family can contest the election for the same school.
5. Parents/guardians can be members of more than one School Council as long as their children attend those schools.

6. In the case of Resource Centres, only parents whose children are registered as full-time students can participate in the elections, both as candidates as well as voters.
7. Parents/guardians of students in the last year of school may be nominated for the elections. Once their children finish school, it is up to them to decide whether or not to continue as members until the end of the School Council's term.
8. Parents/guardians, who are also educators, can be nominated both as Representatives of the Educators as well as Representatives of the Parents on the same Council. However, if they are elected for both posts they will have to choose one post. Educators whose children attend a different school from where they teach can be Representatives of Educators in the school where they are assigned and Representatives of Parents in their children's school.
9. Elections **will only be held** in those schools where more than three (3) nominations are submitted.

Nominations can be submitted online on the website of the Ministry for Education at schoolcouncilelections.edu.mt. One can nominate him/herself. Online nominations open on the 12th December 2022.
