

ILD Class - Important Information and Stationery List

Welcome to the ILD Class!

Hereunder are some important notes:

1. Absence

If for a valid reason, such as medical appointments, a student needs to be picked up early from school, kindly inform the school beforehand via email - scc.stjulians.pr@ilearn.edu.mt

It is important that if students are sick, they rest up at home. In the case of absenteeism, parents/guardians are expected to justify the reason according to the regulations stipulated by the school - a medical certificate and the Medical Record Card, duly signed by the doctor, must be presented for three days or more; and the absence form to report absences of one or two days.

2. School Uniform

The school uniform identifies the students with a school, thereby promoting a sense of pride and a sense of belonging. Students are expected to attend school in full uniform. Please **label everything** with your child's name including the winter jacket, PE kit and running shoes.



Students are expected to wear the full uniform - this means that the school's tracksuit, polo shirt, t-shirt, shorts, cap and winter jacket should **ONLY** be the ones with the **school logo**.

3. Shoes and Socks

No fancy-coloured shoes and socks are allowed.

Please wear **plain white/ black shoes and socks** - (**no lace up shoes unless the children can tie up the laces themselves**).

4. Hairstyles:

No fancy hairstyles. Hair must always be tidy. Long hair can be tied back using white/black/blue rubber bands (no fancy hairclips or tiebacks).

5. Jewellery:

Jewellery is strictly prohibited. Only ONE pair of stud earrings will be allowed.

With reference to the healthy eating policy, food eaten at school should be healthy. Burgers, sausages, nuggets, and fish fingers are not allowed.

Sweets, chocolate, salted snacks such as crisps and soft drinks, fruit juice, and flavoured water are not allowed either. Only water is allowed.

Please send more fruit and vegetables, sandwiches/wraps...and other healthy options. Parents are kindly requested to ensure that children bring enough lunch/food for two break times.



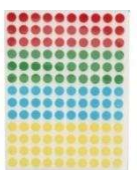
7. Stationery List:

The following is a list of stationery items required throughout the scholastic year.

© The school bag should be big enough for the A4 plastic box file to fit easily.

© To keep in class - please label everything:

- 1 A4 size plastic clipboard (any colour)
- 1 whiteboard (A4 size - anything bigger will not be accepted)
- 20 sticky labels with child's name only written clearly
- 1 antibacterial liquid hand soap
- 3 big rolls of kitchen towels/paper
- 3 big packets of antibacterial wet wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 big bottles of water - labelled
- 1 pencil case with 2 zips (on one side put pencil colours and on the other side put pencils, ruler, rubber, etc.)
- 1 round edged scissors (if the child is left-handed, please buy the specific scissors for left-handed)
- 4 large glue stick (not liquid)
- 2 UHU liquid glue
- 1 PVA glue
- box of poster colours (assorted colours)
- 2 paintbrushes size 10
- 4 empty yogurt cups
- 2 blue whiteboard markers and a small whiteboard eraser
- 2 bingo markers (any colour)
- 10 sheets of stickers (any stickers as long as they are round small)



© To put in the pencil case - please label everything individually:

- 6 **triangular thick** pencils (learner's pencils for easy grip) - there are pencils available for left or right-handed children please choose accordingly for your child
- 1 sharpener with container (to sharpen both thick and thin pencils)
- 1 box of pencil colours
- 1 small ruler - 15 cm long
- 3 rubbers

Important:

This pencil case is going to be kept at school.

You must have another pencil case for home.

© To keep in bag daily:

- 1 narrow plastic box file approx. 3cm wide - **blue colour** (closes with elastic) - HW will be sent in this folder
- 1 A4 plastic envelope (clear transparent colour) in the blue box file - worksheets/school circulars will be sent in this folder
- 1 A5 zip-lock plastic folder (labelled) for school outings
- 1 A5 school diary covered in fancy paper and transparent plastic - these are the thickness of a copybook (do not send anything thicker as the children have to carry this in their bag) - the children will be taking note of their homework in this diary
- A clean napkin (cloth napkin) - changed **EVERYDAY**, a small packet of tissues, and a small packet of wet wipes
- Water bottle
- Lunch box



MAKE SURE THAT THE WATER BOTTLE AND LUNCH BOX ARE EASILY OPENED BY THE CHILDREN THEMSELVES

© Art resources - please label everything individually and put everything in a narrow A4 plastic box file approx. 3cm wide - **black colour** (closes with elastic):

- 2 A4 drawing books (cartridge paper, 130 gsm, which is thick or better for watercolours)
- A plastic cup for water
- Water colours
- One old t-shirt or apron (which will be used during activities to avoid dirtying their uniforms)
- A pencil case with the following inside it:
 - 2 flat paintbrushes (sizes 4 and 6)
 - A cloth to wipe paint brushes
 - Small scissors (round edge)
 - Glue Stick
 - 2B pencil, rubber, sharpener, ruler
 - Pencil colour set

© 1 copybook (**blank pages**) covered in fancy paper and a transparent plastic cover - labelled **Library Book Reviews**



© Craft supplies:

- 2 A4 drawing books (plain pages **not** colouring books)
- 20 sheets of A4 coloured paper (assorted colours)
- 20 sheets of A4 coloured cardboard (assorted colours)
- 10 white (cardboard) paper plates
- 20 pipe cleaners (any colour)
- 20 small pompoms (about 1-2cm diameter) (any colour)
- 1 box of butterfly pins
- 20 cotton buds
- 20 wide wooden lollipop sticks (**not** coloured)

forming a new habit of reading

Research in psychology shows that it takes 21 days for a human being to form a new habit and 90 days to create a lifestyle, so on Mondays and Fridays the children will be given a 10 to 15 minutes of independent reading time in class.

The children are invited to bring their favourite book from home and keep it in their school bag to read during the DEAR time. Pupils are encouraged to read in both English and Maltese. Yes, we celebrate and respect all languages in our class, therefore pupils who can speak in another language can bring a book in that language if they prefer.

This is a technology-free time to limit screen time for the pupils as without any doubt they are spending more than enough time in front of a screen.
