

Year 5 – Stationery List

All things must be labelled with name, surname, class and subject.

Class teacher might ask for additional items at the beginning of the year.

Maths:

x3 120 pages wide lined copybooks (covered with green covers and labelled Maths 1 and Maths 2 and Maths Notes)

x1 1cm squared copybook (covered with a green cover)

English:

x3 64 pages wide lined copybooks (covered with blue covers and labelled English Comprehension, English Creative Writing and English Language)

Blue display file – 50 pockets (labelled English Worksheets)

Maltese:

x4 64 pages wide lined copybooks (covered with red covers and labelled Malti Tàhrig il-fehem, Malti Kitba, Malti Lingwa and Malti Vokabularju)

Red display file – 50 pockets (labelled Malti Worksheets)

My Journal:

x1 64 pages wide lined copybook (covered in fancy paper and labelled My Journal)

Others:

x1 dictionary (Maltese to English and English to Maltese)

x1 labels sheet

x2 packs of sticky notes

x1 foolscaps 80 pages

x1 A4 whiteboard + black, red, green and blue white board markers and an eraser

x1 clipboard

x1 black ring file labelled with name and class

x2 A4 transparent pocket folders with button labelled Circulars and Reading Books

Pencil case: 2 pencils, 2 blue pens, 2 green pens, small ruler, long ruler, rubber, sharpener and 2 highlighters

Arts and crafts: box file including A4 drawing book (130gsm), 2B pencil, black permanent marker- fine point, 2 flat paint brushes (size 4 and size 6), glue stick, PVA glue, round-edged scissors, coloured pencils and sharpener, watercolours, cup, old towel/cloth.
